**How a Switzerland holiday went terrible wrong...

BBQ Haloumi with strawberry salsa




Refreshing, delicious and WHO DOESNT LOVE HALOUMI...

- 250g strawberries, finely chopped
- 1/2 small red onion, finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons lime juice
- 2 teaspoons honey
- 1/4 cup coarsely chopped coriander
- 2 tablespoons finely shredded mint
- 1 red chilli, seeded, finely chopped
- 1 1/2 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 x 250g haloumi pkts, cut into small thick slices

Combine the strawberry, onion, lime juice, honey, coriander, mint, chilli, if using, and 1 tablespoon of the oil in a medium bowl. Season.

Heat a barbecue or chargrill on high. Lightly brush the haloumi with remaining oil. Cook, in batches, for 1 min each side or until charred. Transfer to a serving platter. Top with strawberry mixture. Serve and enjoy.
